

MARIETTA SQUARE FARMERS MARKET








On December 19, 1834, Marietta became legally recognized as a village, two years after Cobb County was established. By the mid-1840s, Marietta's population was around 1,500 residents. In January 1852, the village officially incorporated as a city due to the operation of the new Western and Atlanta Railroad. Visitors can explore the city's history by visiting some of Marietta's myriad local museums and cemeteries.





The Old Zion Baptist Church is only one of more than a dozen stops on the Marietta Black Heritage Walking Tour. On this self-guided tour, you can learn about Marietta's first black city councilman, the Blue Eagle Fire Company, Turner Chapel Church, and more. Download the Black Heritage Walking Tour guide at visitmariettaga.com.

Museums

COBB/MARIETTA MUSEUM OF ART

This museum dedicated to works of American Art houses traveling exhibitions as well as a permanent exhibit.

FIRE MUSEUM

This unique spot honors the Marietta Fire Department and houses the c. 1879 Silsby Steamer, as well as other antique firefighting memorabilia. It's a fun outing for all ages.

MARIETTA GONE WITH THE WIND MUSEUM AT BRUMBY HALL

This destination features memorabilia from the famed book and movie, including costumes, props, posters, books, and Scarlett's original bengaline honeymoon gown.

MARIETTA MUSEUM OF HISTORY

Housed in the Kennesaw House, once a Civil War-era hotel, this museum tells the rich history of Marietta's past through permanent and special exhibits.

OLD ZION BAPTIST CHURCH HERITAGE MUSEUM

This museum is dedicated to the preservation of the history, art, and culture of the black community in Cobb County. Zion Baptist Church was organized in 1866, when its original members pulled out of Marietta's First Baptist Church, where they were once slave members.

WILLIAM ROOT HOUSE MUSEUM & GARDEN

Visit the oldest home remaining in downtown Marietta to experience life of a middle-class family living in antebellum Georgia. The home is meticulously restored to its 1860s appearance, and you can stroll the site's gardens, too.


